Frequently Asked Questions

How large will the center be?

At the completion of the first phase build out, the center will be more than 40,000 square feet. When the last phase is completed the center will be about 87,000 square feet.

What services will be available?

The center will focus on primary care, including family practice, obstetrics and pediatric services. Internal medicine for adults 65 and older will be a secondary focus. Ancillary services such as X-ray and laboratory services will also be available.

How many physicians will be there?

There will be space for as many as 18 physicians at the completion of the first phase. As the population around the center increases, Banner will expand the facility and increase the number of physicians in the center, which will include selected specialists to support their primary care colleagues.

What other specialists will be there?

Physicians with specialties in cardiology, general surgery and orthopedics will be available on certain days by appointment.

What hours will the center be open?

The daily operating hours will be 7 a.m. to 9 p.m. Weekend hours have not been established.

Will urgent care services be available?

Yes. The center will have after-hours care. Urgent care needs will be handled by the physicians on staff.

Will my insurance be accepted?

Banner is included in nearly all the health plans in the metro Phoenix area including TriCare/Champus. Check with your insurance plan for coverage.



When will you begin hiring?

Approximately three months prior to opening, Banner will start recruiting to fill the new positions.

How many employees will be hired?

When the center opens, there will be four to six physicians along with 12 to 18 additional staff.

How can I keep up to date on what is happening at the site?

Banner will periodically send press releases to all local print and online news media. In addition, a website has been created to view new information.
